**Subject:** Mobile Text Alerts for Changes in Center's Operating Status

The Goddard Office of Communications will begin disseminating text alerts about the operating status of the Greenbelt facility. This service will be offered in conjunction with existing methods of notification as stated in the 2015-2016 Snow Plan Announcement, which can be found at <a href="http://code220.gsfc.nasa.gov/Snow/SnowPlanAnnouncement.html">http://code220.gsfc.nasa.gov/Snow/SnowPlanAnnouncement.html</a>.

Employees must opt in to allow their personal and/or business cellphones to receive the text alerts by sending a text message to 333111 with GSFCGBLT in the body of the text.

Message and data rates may apply depending on your mobile provider. Check with your mobile provider for charges and plans.

Employees who opt in to receive the Center's operating status alerts will receive a confirmation from the text service provider Nixle and will later receive an abbreviated text message when a change in the Center's operating status is issued.

This service only collects the phone number from the device you select to receive the messages and does not collect any personal identifiable information or other details. To opt out of the service you would reply with "STOP."
